Ben Kiley is an international music director and educator based in Manhattan. Obtaining his BMus from The University of Melbourne in Australia, Ben has performed throughout Australia and Asia on productions of A Chorus Line, Spamalot and The Music of Andrew Lloyd Webber. Previously he has worked as assistant conductor/pianist for the critically acclaimed production of Fiddler on the Roof (in Yiddish) directed by Joel Grey. Ben also served as lecturer and acting-program leader of the BA(Hons) Musical Theatre

TECHNICAL SPECS AND TOURING INFORMATION

Running time: 45 minutes no intermission. Option for a1 hour version also. Bump in/out times: Ideally 30 mins either side with a 2 hour technical rehearsal

<u>Staging:</u> This production is very adaptable to various performance spaces. The show is a solo performance by Carla Kissane: actor/singer, writer, producer.

<u>Set pieces:</u> A small table for water, DSL. A standing fan at full height. A small table DSR, upon which a wooden book containing paper confetti is placed. Papers and confetti are strewn over the stage floor. Placards containing political propanganda are preset onstage and removed by an actor before the show starts. A music stand, USR

<u>FX:</u> A dinner bell is used many times as a 'reset' throughout the show, this is plotted into the prompt script and is best handled by the sound or lighting operator.

<u>Personal Props:</u> 2 wooden books, each containing papers and confetti -the larger is preset on the music stand and the smaller on the DSR table.

A conductor's baton, preset USC, and used by the actor throughout.

Audience text pieces are preset on the table DSR, including the audition script.

A glass of water on a small table DSL (drunk from throughout the show).

Gertrude uses sunglasses, a folder, collects the placards and repurposes the audition script as a sword.

<u>Costume Pieces:</u> A pink tutu is removed by Carlotta, and a black cape is used as a prop throughout.

Accompaniment: The show is performed either with live band (minimum piano) or on a professionally recorded backing track - depending on space and venue capacity. This worked well at His Majesty's Theatre, Perth and Arts on Site, New York. It requires two technicians to operate lighting & sound if backing tracks are used.

<u>Audio:</u> Wireless microphone and stand would be ideal, connected to the sound desk. Headset / lavalier microphone has also been successfully used in the past, patched into the sound desk. Potential to perform without amplification depending on the space. Small venue would be appropriate. (50-100 seats optimal)

Touring Info

Minimum: There are two members of the touring party, Actor/Singer: Carla Kissane and Actor Grant Cartwright, plus 2 venue technicians to assist with bump in & operate lx & sfx & fx throughout the show. (This was achieved successfully at His Majesty's Theatre)

<u>Set/Props:</u> Wireless microphone and stand, small table with glass of water onstage. Can be performed a capella depending on venue / capacity.

<u>Lighting:</u> Ideally a minimum of a 10 channel lighting plot. Center spot, basic red / blue / green / pink wash, and general wash. Dressing rooms: One dressing room would be ideal.

Content Information

The show does NOT contain the following elements:

- strobe lighting
- smoke or haze effects
- loud noises
- smoking
- Hazardous materials
- Flame effect

PETTY TYRANT is recommended for ages 13 years or older and contains some adult content and coarse language.
